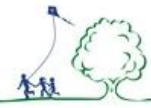











KNOW YOUR TREES



Get to know the trees in the Woods. Take a walk and see if you can find these 6 trees and put a tick by the ones you see. There are a lot of them here!

<p>1.</p>  <p>Beech tree</p>	 <p>Beech nuts (They have rough cases and the squirrels love the nuts)</p>	 <p>Beech leaves</p>
<p>2.</p>  <p>Sycamore Tree</p>	 <p>Sycamore Seeds (sometimes called 'keys')</p>	 <p>Sycamore leaf</p>
<p>3.</p>  <p>Sweet Chestnut Tree (Look for the twisty trunk)</p>	 <p>Sweet Chestnut seeds/nuts (They have prickly cases)</p>	 <p>Sweet Chestnut leaves</p>

Rowan leaves

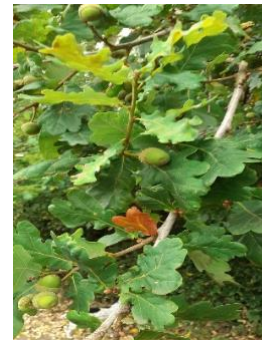
